### 1. System Alternatives



### A. Water Supply & Treatment Facility: \$2,100,000

- · Extend building.
- · Install new package filter unit.
- · Replace high service pumps.
- Replace pump/filter controls and process piping valves.
- · Replace faulty generator.
- New pumps and well rehabilitation for wells 5 & 6.
- Rehabilitate well 4A.



### B. Water Storage Tanks:

- a. Rehabilitate: \$900,000
  - i. Sandblast, prime and paint existing elevated tanks
  - ii. Allowance for extensive repairs.
- b. Rehabilitate 200,000 gal, Replace 75,000 gal: \$1,700,000
- C. IDEM Lead and Copper Rule Compliance: \$375,000 \$400,000
  - a. Replace 26 service lines
- D. Water Distribution System Improvements: \$1,750,000
  - a. Improve undersized mains affecting 3 neighborhoods for fire flows
